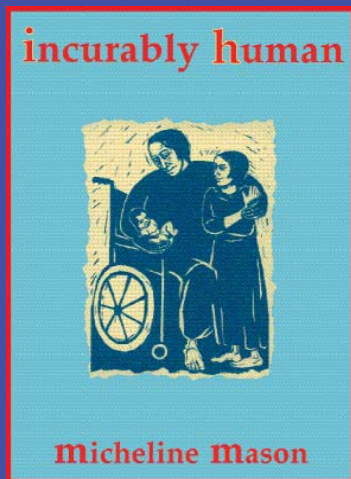

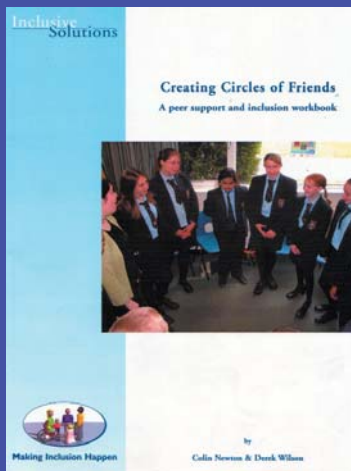
## Incurably Human by Micheline Mason
